1. Who we are and what this policy covers

2. Information we may collect

Depending on your relationship with us, we may collect identity and contact details; account and authentication information; verification and due-diligence records; professional, financial and suitability information; transaction and payment records; device, usage and technical information; communications and support requests; marketing preferences; and information from authorised representatives, public sources, fraud-prevention, sanctions-screening and service providers.

We may also receive information about beneficial owners, directors, controllers and other connected persons where an account or law requires it. Please do not send sensitive personal information through an unsecured channel unless we request it through a secure process.

3. Why we use information

We use information to assess applications; verify identity; establish and manage accounts; provide, secure and support the Services; process payments and withdrawals; execute and record transactions where applicable; detect and prevent fraud, money laundering and other financial crime; meet legal, regulatory, audit and recordkeeping duties; improve the Services; communicate important service notices; and, where permitted, send relevant marketing.

Where a GDPR-style law applies, the final local notice will identify the applicable legal basis for each purpose, such as contract, legal obligation, legitimate interests or consent. You can withdraw marketing consent at any time using the link in a message or by contacting us.

4. Sharing and international transfers

We may share information with group companies, technology and hosting providers, identity and screening providers, payment providers, professional advisers, auditors, regulators, law enforcement, execution or liquidity counterparties where applicable, and parties involved in a corporate transaction. We do so only where a valid purpose and legal basis exists and with appropriate safeguards.

We may process information outside your country. When a law restricts international transfers, we will use the required transfer mechanism and provide relevant details in the applicable local notice.

5. Security and retention

We use proportionate technical, organisational and physical safeguards. No internet-based system is entirely secure. Notify us promptly at [SECURITY EMAIL] if you suspect unauthorised account access or a privacy/security issue.

We retain personal information for the period necessary for the purpose collected and to meet legal, regulatory, tax, limitation-period, audit and dispute requirements. The final retention periods must be stated or otherwise made available in the approved retention schedule.

6. Your privacy choices and rights

Subject to applicable law and identity verification, you may have rights to access, correct, delete, restrict or object to processing, receive portable information, withdraw consent, opt out of certain marketing or data sharing, and complain to a supervisory authority. We may need to retain information or decline part of a request where an exemption or legal obligation applies. If we cannot complete a request, we will explain the reason to the extent law permits.

7. Cookies, children and updates

We use cookies and similar technologies as described in our Cookie Notice and consent settings. Non-essential technology will be activated only as the applicable law and consent choice permit.
